

**18th Graduation Ceremony
December 2019**

Date of the Graduation

There will be 2 ceremonies as follows:

1. Wednesday 11 Dec. 2019. This ceremony will celebrate graduates of the Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Education & Arts, and Faculty of Computer and Information Technology.
2. Thursday 12 Dec. 2019. This ceremony will celebrate the Faculty of Business, Faculty of Language Studies, and Faculty of Law.

Before the day of graduation

Graduates are advised to login online and complete their registration to attend the ceremony. To do so follow these steps:

- You should receive a confirmation email with a barcode.

You are requested to be at the campus at least three hours before the start of the ceremony.

Collecting your robes & tickets

Once your registration to attend the ceremony has been accepted and approved, you can collect your robes from Mahatat Altalaba (Shinas building), Sohar University starting 25 Nov. to 7 Dec. 19, Sat. to Thurs. from 10 am to 6 pm.

Your tickets will be sent to you via emails.

Each graduate is allocated three tickets. One ticket for the graduate, and two tickets for members of your family. A place has been booked for female graduates to dress and prepare themselves on the day of the graduation. Another location has been booked for male graduates to dress and prepare themselves. Somebody to tie turbans for graduates would be available for male graduates (fees apply to turban tie).

Photographs

You could find photographers near the graduation ceremony venue (there are numbers of photographers available).

You can arrange for printing and size of your photos with the photographers.

Taking personal photos in the ceremony venue is prohibited. You can take photos in the dedicated areas for photography.

Personal belongings

You are advised not to bring your personal belongings into the graduation venue. Personal belongings include purses, handbags, mobile phones and any other items you cannot keep in your pocket.

Your robes will not have pockets - we recommend that you keep your belongings in your home/ car, or ask your guests to look after your belongings during the ceremony.

Mobile phones and cameras in the ceremony

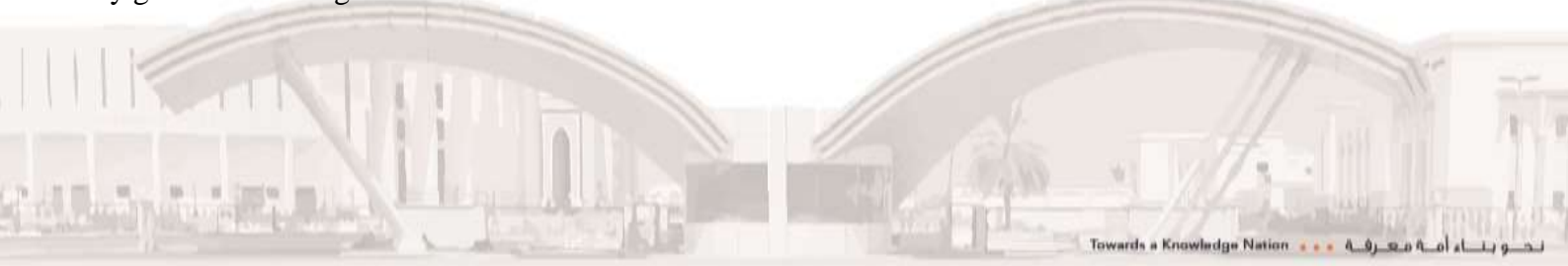
Use of mobile phones, cameras or any portable electronic device is not permitted during the graduation as it can cause disruption to other graduates and guests. Any graduates or guests seen using such equipment will be asked to leave the graduation.

If you would like a photograph of you receiving your degree on stage during the ceremony, you can have one by one of the photographers as this is part of the photograph options available to you.

Don't be late!

The doors to the graduation venue will close 30 minutes before the start of the ceremony to both graduates and guests. This is to ensure that the ceremony runs smoothly.

Any graduate arriving after the doors have closed will not be allowed to receive their certificate.
